5.	Report on Council arrangements for staff dismissals/redundancies together with loss of accommodation and the total costs involved
6.	Report of measures in place to maintain the properties while taken out of use including safety, insurance and the likely annual costs
7.	Report on the list of total properties “in trust for the nation” by name (at the 2008 AGM)
